1. Call to Order

Called to order at 9:30 AM.

2. Chair's Opening Remarks

Chair Sheard opened the meeting.

3. Approval of Agenda

Addition: Item 6A - For Information: Update on provincial flood mapping.

Moved by Reeve Boehlke, Seconded by Mayor Snodgrass, accepted by Chair.

Motion: That the Calgary Metropolitan Region Land Use Committee approve the agenda of the meeting with the addition of Agenda Item 6A and modification to remove closed session and keep Agenda Item 6 in public session.

Motion carried with a majority.

4. Review and Approve Minutes



Moved by Mayor Robertson, Seconded by Mayor Genung, accepted by Chair.

Motion: That the Calgary Metropolitan Region Land Use Committee approve the Minutes of the July 5, 2018 meeting as presented.

Motion carried unanimously.

5. Population Projections

Liisa Tipman introduced Ryan Berlin of Rennie Group, joined by telephone, who described the results of the Population Projections study completed by Rennie Group and reviewed through TAG and municipal experts to establish regional population projections.

Moved by Mayor Robertson, Seconded by Reeve Spilak, accepted by Chair.

Motion: That the Calgary Metropolitan Region Land Use Committee recommend for approval by the Board the Populations Projections ultimately for use in the Growth Plan and recommended Population Projections be updated by CMRB at least once every 5 years.

Motion carried unanimously.

6. Interim Growth Plan and Interim REF

Chair Sheard laid out import of timeliness of completion of the document and delivery to the Government of Alberta for approval by January 1, 2019, in consideration of provincial election schedule.

There was a presentation by consultants ISL/USI of status of the IGP document and high level principles and objectives.

Mayor Brown arrived at 10:56 am.

Discussion by the committee and direction to consultants and CMRB administration was given on floodway and flood fringe policy development, country residential development, and the interim regional evaluation framework (IREF) criteria.

Motion moved by Reeve Boelke, **Seconded** by Mayor Snodgrass, accepted by Chair.



Motion:

Whereas the Technical Advisory Group have made substantial progress in the development of an *Interim Growth Plan* and *Interim Regional Evaluation Framework; and*

Whereas there remains additional work to be completed as identified in Section 6 of the Agenda Package.

Therefore be it resolved:

THAT the *Interim Growth Plan* and *Interim Regional Evaluation Framework* be referred back to the Technical Advisory Group in order to: (i) provide additional definition and policy clarity; (ii) attempt to reach consensus on the matters identified in Section 6 of the Agenda Package; and (iii) address other matters identified by the Land Use Committee and Technical Advisory Group; and

THAT the *Interim Growth Plan* and the *Interim Regional Evaluation Framework* be brought back to the Land Use Committee on September 21, 2018 for discussion and decision.

Motion carried unanimously.

6A. Based on information from the province of Alberta, the Growth Plan must be developed in the absence of updated flood mapping.
