1. Call to Order

2. Chair's Opening Remarks

3. Approval of Agenda

5. IREF

a. Selection of Third Party Consultants

The Committee received an update on the Third Party Consultant selection process. A group of five qualified consultants have been selected and contracts are currently being finalized. The consultants are: B&A Planning Group, ISL Engineering and Land Services, 02 Design and Planning, Situated Co. and Stantec. The consultants will be chosen by rotating through an established order, unless a conflict arises upon which the next in line will be contacted.

b. Interpretation Guide

The Committee discussed this item and asked that the following changes be made and brought to the Board for approval:

- o CMRB Administration to add a few sentences to the Guide addressing who can speak to the Board regarding an IREF application. The sentences should be explicit that a member of municipal administration or other technical expert familiar with the statutory plan may present on the municipality's behalf.
- o CMRB Administration to amend the Guide to be consistent in its use of terms, picking either challenge or objection.
- CMRB Administration to amend Section 5.3 paragraph 2 of the Guide to say, "The member municipality who submitted the application will also have an opportunity, assisted by technical experts, to present its reasons for requesting approval of the application." (exact wording to be determined)

Motion: That the Calgary Metropolitan Region Land Use Committee recommend the IREF Interpretation Guide and IREF Application Checklist to the Board for approval with the changes noted.

6. RFP for Growth Plan Consultants

Liisa Tipman provided an update on the process for selection of a Growth Plan Consultant, with an ideal RFP posting date of March 2019. Members discussed the desire to have local and international proposals, and how to encourage that in the Request for Proposal and locations of posting.



7. Environmentally Sensitive Areas

a. Speaker Series

Guy Greenaway provided a presentation on Environmentally Sensitive Areas.

b. ESA Request for Study

The Committee discussed the need to ensure the Growth Plan fully considers and incorporates environmentally sensitives areas. Although each member municipality has expert staff who have created inventories, the same criteria and parameters are not used. In order to support the growth planning process, a background study would help to identify existing studies, data and mapping, and provide suggested policy directions or best practices. Updates on the study, including scope and budget, will be brought back to the committee.

Motion: That the Calgary Metropolitan Region Land Use Committee direct CMRB Administration to undertake a study around environmentally sensitive areas.
